HOURS & LOCATION

Our summer camp program is located at our new Club house site, Elsmere School, 801 Ellis Street, Glassboro, from June 29th through August 21st. Our camp opens it's doors at 7:00am each morning and closes at 6:00pm. For the safety of our camper's it is our policy that each camper be signed in and signed out by an adult each day at camp. In addition, there is a \$1.00 per minute late pick-up fee assessed to any parent who picks up their child later than 6:00pm.

BREAKFAST & LUNCH

All campers should come to the program with a bagged lunch each day. Campers are also permitted to bring a light breakfast in the morning, and the Boys & Girls Club will provide a nutritional snack for our campers each afternoon. In addition there will occasionally be a field trip where our campers will have the options to buy their lunches at the field trip site. We will be sure to let you know when buying a lunch is an option on the weekly camp agendas!



FIELD TRIPS

Every year the Boys & Girls Clubs of Gloucester County makes an effort to provide our summer campers with unique experiences outside of the actual camp site. This year we will again be providing our campers with an assortment of fun-filled field trips including skating at the Franklinville Skating Center, Swimming at the Rowan University Pool, exploring nature at Parvin State Park, and taking in a baseball game with the Atlantic City Surf.
